TRACI GIRL never far back, raced four wide into the turn when moving closer, challenged before a half, drew clear into the stretch and held sway late. SAVANNAH HANNA within striking distance, raced six wide into the turn, angled in a bit with three furlongs to go then closed well late. LADY JUSTINE outrun early, raced four wide on the turn and lodged a mild late bid. DREAM CITY far back for a half, found her best stride too late. DOVE CREEK alternated for the lead three wide and tired. LIFE SAVIOR vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. ALL BY CHANCE close up from the start, was five wide entering the turn and gave way. SWEET CHERE tired along the inside. ASHLAR forwardly placed on the rail, stopped.
