ONE LUCKY STORM never far back racing wide down the backstretch, came widest around the turn and prevailed in an all out drive. SHE BE FAPIANO never far back, finished well between horses and just missed in a game effort. ISLAND SAGA never far back, moved through on the inside turn and finished well on the rail too late. LADY'S ROOM tracked the lead, gained a short lead into the stretch but weakened late. JUST ONE BID bobbled at the start, recovered quickly raced up close and faded in the stretch run. WILD JEZABEL failed to menace. TARRAH TRICK showed good speed, dueled to the stretch and gave way. J STAR had good early foot, bore out on the turn and dropped back in distress late.
