ON A CLEAR DAY closest to pace three wide, took over on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. WISE ROMANCE four wide on the first turn when within striking distance, lodged a mild bid to be second best. INLAY set the pace inside, stayed well to the stretch and tired. MOODY STAR unhurried early, raced four wide on the second turn and was no real threat. EIGHTYSIX COLUMNS, unhurried early four wide, raced in the same path on the second turn and was no factor. SHOOTINGFORTHEGOLD four wide on the first turn when outrun, raced five wide on the second turn and was no factor. SEPTEMBER CHARMER was outrun. BLOW THE FUZE flashed speed.
