PRIZE STORY always well placed, rushed up on the turn, hooked the leader through the final furlong in a long battle then won the head bob while all out. FIRST MONEY went up inside to take the lead, dueled inside through the stretch with the eventual winner and lost the head bob at the wire. AMERICAN THUNDER perfectly placed on the inside to stretch, angled out for the drive with no late gain. MOSSANT well placed to the turn, roused with no response. MENASHA no speed and only improved position his late. GAMBLE MONGER staked leaders to the turn and gave way. PAY CHECK failed to menace. AWESOMEBABYAWESOME no speed, went wide on the turn and never threatened. PRUNERIDENTIAL was outrun. BRAVE 'N AWAY was no factor. WILL BELONG sent early from outside, vied for a half and stopped.
