STORMY ATLANTIS set the pace early, while on the inside in the far turn then remained clear in the stretch and held sway late. ROCKHOUSE ROCKET stalked the pace early four wide, angled into the three path in the far turn the bid in the stretch but missed late. PURELY WILD was far back early, angled off the rail in the far turn then rallied in the stretch but was too late. MANSMIND was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. NEED MONEY DAD was reserved early, angled into the four path in the far turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch. EL BOMBA angled into the five in the far turn with some gain in the stretch. GRETCHEN'S STAR swung into the six path in the far turn and improved position late. CANOE IN A SLEW tracked the pace early from the between horses, angled off the rail in the far turn and faded late. CANE GARDEN BOY was through

after a half. MEISTERWERK raced up close early while on the inside in the far turn then soon retreated. ACK MAGICAL was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn then folded up. BROTHER RON was done early.
