PURE GRANIT had an inside trip while close up to the turn, got through entering the stretch and drew clear under steady encouragement. OUTTA TUNE never far back to the turn, drifted out six wide into the stretch and got up for place. HE'S NO PIKER chased leader to the stretch, was under heavy right handed urging when rider lost control after the dropping the reins then held well for the third spot. MALIBU MIX showed no speed to the turn, swung widest into stretch and moved up late. DOWN THE TRACK stumbled at the start, held good position, angled in around foe in the late going from the rail. MAMMOTH STORM stumbled at the start, raced back early and improved position through the stretch. UNO MACHO WHIZ was bounced around at the start, raced inside at the quarter pole but faded in the drive. MORNING BILL was through early. DANCING DON was through after a half. RAPID DEVELOPMENT had good speed to set pace for a half but stopped while bearing out late. CAJUN GOLD failed to menace. SHEIK OF KENTUCKY always trailed.
