Footnotes

MOA ANNETTE vied for the lead three wide, shook clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. LADY SEATTLE was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling six wide, closed willingly and was up in time to earn the place. ROCKETINTHEGATE was forwardly placed between horses three deep, split horses entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally for the show. SWEET HENNESSY stalked the pace four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. MISSY WILDCAT settled in hand and tucked in to save ground, angled to the outside leaving the turn, offered a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SILVER DIGGER contended along the inside early, dropped back to last through the turn, swung to the outside and improved her position late. VANILLA BABE made a middle move circling six wide, drew even nearing the quarter pole, but was used up after a half and dropped out. SILVERY TUNE contended off of the inside, drifted out entering the lane but lacked a response when called upon. TOSCA'S KISS pressed the pace along the inside through the turn and dropped out. STAR OF THE GLEN was away alertly to set the pressured pace from between horses for a half and stopped.
