Footnotes

ONCE IS ENOUGH was away alertly and dueled for the lead two wide, opened clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. VISION OF DANYMAC angled in to save ground, ranged into striking distance through the turn, split horses and angled out entering the stretch, loomed large but weakened during the drive and just held the place. RICHWOOD AFFAIR broke slowly, angled out to be clear, made a long drive circling eight wide, continued on well and was gaining. NOON DAY was allowed to settle into stride, angled in entering the turn, made a mild rally from between horses but failed to seriously threaten. KRYSTAL SLIPPER made a middle move five wide, drew even nearing the quarter pole, but faltered during the drive and faded. MISS HAVERSTICK dropped far back, swung to the outside entering the stretch, finished fairly well but was left with too much to do. GAFFNEY STATION was unhurried into stride, angled out five wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. LOVE THE ARTS bobbed at the start, rushed to contention from between horses, but was used up after a half and dropped out. KENTUCKY KITTY chased the pace along the inside early but was through before going a half. TITHE was forwardly placed three wide through the turn and stopped. ALGAZARA rushed up to vie for the lead along the inside, was taken up leaving the three-eighths pole, eased to the wire but walked off.
