**Footnotes**

SHEZA POSSEBILITY stalked the pace, launched her bid four wide, opened clear and maintained a safe advantage. ACACIAN SPIRIT attended the pace along the inside, got through to make her move, but was unable to match strides with the winner. OCTOBER SONG broke slow, settled saving ground, advanced between horses, angled out four wide but flattened during the drive. LILLEANDRA was allowed to settle, moved up five wide through the second turn, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SLEW WATER SLEW was taken in hand, settled six wide, finished with a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. REAL OBVIOUS was allowed to settle four wide and lacked a response when called upon. GO GO BIRDIE set the pressured pace three wide, came up empty between horses after five furlongs and retreated. JEAN'S MEMORY disputed the pace four wide for a half and dropped out.
