Footnotes

ICANROLL no speed, advanced wide into stretch, started in the eighth path at quarter pole, drifted in through the final furlong impeding HEY BILL in the process and held on. HEY BILL never far back from inside, was trapped down on the rail and steadied around the turn, finally got through then was shut off in mid stretch by ICANROLL, continued on to just miss while being tons the best. SILENT KILLER had good position, was blocked into the final turn, shook clear into the stretch but with no gain. SEA OF VICTORY well placed and never far back, loomed three wide around the turn stretch but faded through the stretch run. RIVER BOTTOM OAK trailed for a half and only improved position through the stretch. SULTRY PLEASURE had good speed from outside, dueled to the quarter pole and faded. SILVER BISCUIT unhurried early, shuffled back down the backstretch and improved position through the stretch run.

FOUR YOUR MARQ well placed while never far back, drifted out at the quarter pole and stopped. HAIR TRIGGER failed to menace. ISLAND HEAT had no speed to the final turn, moved widest through the stretch, while no factor. LYNN'S VISION showed speed to duel for three quarters from inside then gave way. BEHRENS DESIGN was through after a half.
