Footnotes

AXIOM set a pressured pace throughout from off rail, dug in when headed at furlong pole then held on gamely at the wire. YANKEESSWEPTINFOUR up close to the turn, eased out into the stretch, drew even with winner at the furlong marker but was out nodded on the wire. GUINNESS CHARLIE never far back, moved four wide into the turn with no late gain. NEVER THERE raced evenly and lacked a late response. POISON PILL never a menace. IMPRESSIVE COMMAND closest to pace for a half but weakened in the stretch from off the rail. FAST N READY taken back and to the outside soon after the start, stayed widest with no run. GAMBLER'S HONOUR was no real threat. STEDS PIRATE was through early.
