### Footnotes

BIG GLEN with the pace early, was shuffled back from inside around the final, angled out through the stretch and came again to prevail at the wire. WORKINONTRAILROAD unhurried early, angled out into the stretch, rallied but was outfinished in the late going. GREGORY'S TRICK never far back, gained the lead around the turn, led into stretch but tired in the drive. SARATOGA SEVEN pressed between horses to the turn and gave way. COMMAND SGT. MAJOR had no speed to the turn, rallied through the stretch and only improved position. NAFASS was through after a half. THEBOB in good position for three quarters but gave way. DA DA DA DUM stayed within striking distance to stretch and also gave way. WITH WINGS was never a menace. BUNKER set a pressured pace for a half and stopped. FACE THE FIRE was never a factor.
