**Footnotes**

LM PRECISIONS TIME was away alertly, angled in to set the pace, shook clear after a half and drew away to score as the rider pleased. LITTLEBITCRANKY was allowed to settle, circled five wide, finished well and clearly proved second best. NAKASANJE (ITY) stalked the pace three wide, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. TOMO NIGHTS was unhurried into stride, came six wide and improved position through the lane. FINISH YOUR DRINK was unhurried into stride, finished with a late rally between horses but failed to threaten. SILK AND GEMS was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and faded. LILLYS SIS passed the tiring ones. SAQQARAH contended four wide through the turn and retreated. CARLA AND ELAINE stumbled at the start, rushed up between horses, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. WRONG SONG was outrun. MARIA DE SLEW broke slow, rushed up between horses, checked hard before going a quarter and showed little thereafter.
