Footnotes

RICHLAND CREEK well placed while never far back, made a four wide bid into the turn gained command and drew off in a steady drive. PREACHINUPASTORM up close from the outset, went three wide with a bid to lead into the final furlong but was no match late. FIVE STAR DAWN pressed the pace for a half, angled out but came up empty in the drive. MY PAL ALEX never far back between horses, lacked room into the stretch, altered course around tiring horses and finished well late. FOR YOU REppo showed no speed to the quarter pole, went extremely wide around the turn and moved up through the stretch run. PRIOR BARON vied for lead to deep stretch but faded in the drive. FRISK failed to menace while wide in to the turn. SENOR SQUALL never far back, floated five wide into turn while no real menace. BALLACOLLA was outrun. LORD BUCKY was through after a half. LIVER UP showed speed to the stretch from inside and stopped. IT'S FATE was outrun.
