THECLEVEREST stumbled at the start, tracked leaders to the turn, came four wide for the drive, dueled through the final furlong and was able to edge clear in the final strides. RENDEZVOUS SIOUX back early from inside, moved out for the drive, dueled through the stretch but was out gamed in the final stages. MISS RERUN good speed to draw clear at once, held a clear lead into stretch but shortened stride late. ROSE' WINE close up to the stretch, put in tight and altered course at the three sixteenth pole with no gain. COULEE had good position but failed to respond in the drive. ALLEY SINGER was never a factor. RAH RAH GIRL was through early, dropped far back and labored through the final furlong. ORPHAN'S DREAM was never close, pulled up in distress in the stretch and subsequently vanned off.
