AMERICAN EPIC sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and increased his advantage under steady urging. MOGAMBO JON reserved early, steadied with three furlongs to go when blocked, got through inside soon after, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch but had no late bid. JANTZER forwardly placed inside, came off the rail on the turn but lacked a late bid. KING HIGH outrun early, made a good inside move into the turn, was angled out entering the stretch and finished well. SEVEN ON DICE closest to the pace in the three path, stayed well to midstretch and tired. GOLDEN OLDIE outrun early, was angled out in upper stretch but could not threaten. OUT OF THE CRISIS within striking distance three wide, gave way in the drive. APPLE BARRY reserved early, raced five wide on the turn and could not menace. FAN THE FIRE within striking distance between rivals, faded. OLYZEUS was no factor.
