EMILY'S MARK never far back, rallied into the turn and stretch but had no late gain. BECKY B MINE showed no speed, went wide into the turn and had a mild rally late. OUR MIMI never far back early and failed to respond when needed. IN CASE OF WIND raced close up with the pace to the turn and weakened in the stretch run. R B WOMEN had a steady fade. ORANGEBERRY was no factor. GLORADO was never close. EASTER TRYST was through after half while four wide into the turn.
