Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, December 8, 2005 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$40,000 Guaranteed plus \$10,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds; 121 lbs.; Older; 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2005, allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2005, 4 lbs.; \$21,000 at a mile or over since October 6, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2005. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, November 30, 2005 with 56 Nominations.

TAPPIN FOR GOLD between horses into the first turn, angled in to the rail around the final turn, made an inside rally through a small opening at the furlong pole and drew clear under good handling. LENATAREESE showed no speed to stretch rallied widest through the stretch to get up for place while no match. STAVINSKY'S GAL had good speed from the rail to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly in the late going. PLUMLAKE LADY prompted the early pace for three quarters, made a strong bid approaching the eighth pole but hung late. GOODSPRINGS never far back, rallied up three wide into the final turn then flattened out in the drive. MOON BERRY (BRZ) raced in good position for three quarters and gave way from the turn. SLEW'S SPARKLE was no real threat. GAMBLE TO VICTORY forwardly placed to the quarter pole then gave way thereafter. MISS ELSIE flashed brief speed between horses and gave way after a half. MODENA BAY (NZ) was through early.
