SWEET EUPHORIA moved up four wide from between horses under a snug hold, drew even with a quarter to run, kicked clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. DO YOUR A B C'S pulled to the fore along the inside to dispute the pace, steadied with a quarter to run when STREAM KID came in, angled out and came again to clearly prove second best. MASAI QUEEN settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and was just up to earn the show. STREAM KID stalked the pace three deep, ranged up between horses to contest the pace after a half, but drifted in leaving the second turn and weakened during the drive. ELECTRIC RANGE was hustled along three wide in mid pack, came four wide and finished with a mild rally. WILD BUSHROSE was forwardly placed six wide but lacked a response when called upon. SLYDONNA passed only her tiring rivals. GIDABRIDE broke slowly, angled out six wide to be clear but was never a factor. NAUGHTIEST pressed the pace two wide, but faltered from between horses on the second turn and faded. SUGAH BABY raced wide throughout and was outrun. CAITLINS BALLERINA broke in the air and showed little. CAROLYNS ROSE was through early. The jockey of DO YOUR A B C'S lodged an objection against SWEET EUPHORIA for alleged interference near the quarter pole, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
