Footnotes

CRIMSON KATE settled in hand, moved up four wide through the turn, shook clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. TOSCA'S KISS was away a step slow and unhurried into stride, split horses leaving the turn, angled out and finished well to earn the place. PRINCESS JANELLE was allowed to settle toward the inside, shifted out and advanced four wide through the turn, drifted out further entering the stretch, loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. THUNDER AND BELLE was unhurried, came five wide and finished with a belated gain. BLINGS RISING STAR chased the pace three wide, but faltered between horses and faded. TAPITFORPAR bobbled at the start, rushed to the lead along the inside, came up empty before going a half and retreated. TRUE JEAN settled six wide and failed to respond. VICKI'S TRUMP broke slow, made a middle move to close the gap through the turn, but tired entering the stretch and dropped out.
