Footnotes

CLAYTON'S LUCK was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, circled six wide, cut into the leaders advantage through the upper stretch, caught that OUR KING and quickly drew clear. OUR KING was away alertly to set the pace, opened clear on the backstretch, was headed inside the furlong marker and settled for the place. SARKOZY was unhurried into stride, came five wide and finished well to earn the show. THE ALCOVA KID was unhurried, finished with a belated gain between horses but failed to threaten. OLDHAMBURG attended the pace in hand, moved up four wide through the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. RAHY NIJMIS was forwardly placed between horses, drifted out on the second turn and faded. STARTINGOLD settled between horses and lacked a response when asked. COMMANDER JOHN chased three wide to the second turn and retreated. CAPTAIN KYLE showed little. LIVER lunged at the start, rushed to contention along the inside, but was used up after a half and dropped out.
