Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, December 8, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds; 123 lbs.; Older; 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2011, allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2011. LA GRAN BAILADORA was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied and took over command in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. BRILLIANT FUTURE tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. LA ROCCA was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. ON Z RUN stalked the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but faltered late in the drive. NIJI'S GRAND GIRL was back early, angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position late. GOLDEN GALLEON was on the inside into the far turn and empty in the stretch drive. INCLUDE THE CAT was never a threat. RIVIERA CHIC angled into the four path in the far turn and was faded late. FULL MOON PARTY set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch. JAPANESE GARDEN was through after three quarters. CACTUS CADILLAC had early speed then folded up.
