Footnotes

OFFICERS GLORY attended the pace off of the inside, responded when put to pressure with five-sixteenths to run, angled out leaving the turn, seized command and quickly drew clear. BELLE MUSE was allowed to settle, made a steady advance circling five wide but failed to menace the winner. ENTOMOLOGY settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, came four wide and continued on fairly well to earn the show. PUTTINONAIRS prompted the pace two wide, forged a brief lead leaving the turn, but weakened during the drive and gave way. ANGELS CAN BE WILD stalked the pace four wide, made a middle move to close the gap, but flattened entering the lane and faded. BACK TO HURSTLAND was unhurried into stride, angled in entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. BALITORI set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed before going a half and gave way readily thereafter. WAHL OF FAME failed to respond. RUFF'S SISTER passed the tiring ones. BOTTLEPAN broke slow, raced wide throughout and was never a factor. GONE HOME stumbled at the start, was hustled along to recover the lost ground along the inside, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. VELVET DANCER broke slowly and was always outrun.
