HUGGLE BUBBLE set the pressured pace off of the inside, opened clear entering the stretch and widened through the final furlong. STORMYS PROCLIVITY tracked the pace along the inside, moved up to engage the leader on the turn, was unable to match strides with that one and was all out to hold the place. BANKER'S BRIDE settled in hand toward the inside, angled out leaving the turn, continued on fairly well but was unable to improve position. DIURNAL was allowed to settle, circled six wide and made a late gain. EMMY was hustled along three wide to attend the pace, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. HAYLEY'S BAYLEY broke slow, was unhurried into stride, made a mild rally four wide but failed to threaten. GOD'S BLESSING stumbled and was bumped at the start, never recovered and passed only the tiring ones. REINA SOFIA was hustled along five wide for a half and tired. RAGE FOR FAME saved ground to no avail. R TS ISADORA broke slow, dropped far back and was never a factor. CARRIE ME HOME was through early.
