BULLY stalked the pace three deep, launched her bid entering the stretch, wore down the leader and edged clear late. RNBS BLACKWATEROLL was away alertly to set the pressured pace between horses, was unable to resist the winner but kept on willingly to hold the place. MOLLY'S MOON pressed the pace along the inside, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. EMILY D. settled saving ground, angled out to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. GAFFNEY STATION was bumped and pinched back at the start, finished with a mild rally but was never a factor. BEAVERHEAD ROCK unseated her jockey and ran off in post parade, settled in the second flight and lacked a response. CLASSY AWARD passed only her tiring rivals. PADDLEWRIGHT pressed the pace three wide, but faltered leaving the turn and faded. SPARKY NEKIA was through after a half. SPOKEN WORD broke slowly and trailed throughout.
