### Footnotes

NOLA STAR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn, drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. ELLE SOCIETY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. MISS MUTAK was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late. BIG SIS AND TWINS was back early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. TRUST SLEW stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. MISS KRISIE WHIZ angled into the four path in the far turn and steadily faded throughout. CARRYIN THE DREAM broke awkward from the gate, swung into the six path in the far turn while no factor. BELLA BELLA BAILEY was through after a half. BARBATINA was never involved. LANGZIG was done early.
