SPECIAL SUN chased the pace early while five wide, swung into the six path entering the lane then came in a bit and drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. WHITE RABBIT stalked pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch run. MAGTIME tracked the pace early then took over command, angled into the three path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. MACHO MATT broke awkwardly at the start and hit the gate, improved position late in the stretch. BIG RED BULL was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty late in the stretch drive. AT THE STATION had early speed then folded up.
