TAKIN THE SLOROAD behind the leaders, moved up four wide with three furlongs to go, was carried wide entering the stretch when moving to challenge then drew clear under steady urging. SKILLTOPAYTHEBILLS angled in a bit early, vied for the early lead inside, dropped back a bit, angled out three wide on the second turn, challenged before going six furlongs, drifted wide entering the stretch then held on to be second best while no match for the winner late. STEVIS MAN in close quarters nearing the first turn, was reserved, made a good five wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. HEZRO ducked in at the start bothering inner rivals, was outrun to the stretch and rallied belatedly. KEEP IT TOGETHER with the early pace while off the inside, dropped back a bit before a half then faded. MR. AMERICA bothered at the start, steadied along the inside entering the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance but faded. JUSTFOLLOWMYLEAD with the early leaders three wide, took over before a half, held on for five furlongs and faded. J. R. BUD bothered at the start, raced behind the leaders, was four wide with three furlongs to go and stopped. VANTASTIC MAGIC bore out on the first turn and was pulled up.
