Footnotes

SCREENPLAY forced the pace from the outside, raced four wide midway through the turn and drew clear under steady urging. KUTSA reserved early, raced three wide late on the turn when rallying then finished willingly late to be second best. INGENIUS bothered at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, made a five wide bid on the turn but weakened in the drive. CATNIRO close up along the inside, steadied midway through the turn when challenging from the rail, recovered but weakened in the final furlong. DOUBLE SALTY vied for the lead between rivals and tired in the drive. MISTER STRIKE steadied when roughed at the start, was outrun early, saved ground on the turn then lacked a late bid. TODAY'S TOMORROW within striking distance in the three path, tired. TRICKY TYLER outrun early while racing four wide, was no factor. REAL PRO vied for the lead while just off the rail and faded in the stretch. CODE ONE bore in at the start bothering inner rivals, was straitened to race forwardly, was five wide midway through the turn and faded.
