NAUGHTY MAMBO set the pace while just off the inside and drew off under steady urging. VALID ANTHEM within striking distance, angled out six wide leaving the turn for room then finished willingly for the place. SUDDENLY GONE reserved early, raced five wide on the turn then went evenly in the final furlong. ZIG'S QUIET LADY outrun early, came four wide into the stretch then rallied well while near the rail late. BLUSHING BANANNIE prompted the pace three wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. TWO DOT SLEW reserved early, was fanned seven wide with a quarter mile to run then was no real threat. STRIKING POSES within striking distance, was five wide with three furlongs to go and tired. OLYMPIC CHAMPION forwardly placed along the inside, tired. MISS NIKNAR prompted the pace, was four wide entering the turn and tired. SATSUMA was no factor.
