TREATY OF KADESH settled saving ground, closed the gap through the second turn, split horses entering the stretch, forged a narrow lead, was headed inside the furlong marker, fought back through a prolonged drive and was fully extended to prevail. BABY BROWN EYES settled in hand, advanced between horses, came five wide into the stretch, poked her head in front inside the furlong marker, kept on well but was unable to hold the determined winner at bay. AWESOME BABY BABY was allowed to settle, moved up five wide to make her bid, but lacked the needed late response and settled for the show. THE BIG WHAMMY settled into stride, moved up four wide through the second turn, assumed a brief lead with a quarter to run but failed to sustain the drive. ACTION LADY raced wide throughout, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. PLAIN AND SIMPLE was fractious in the gate, broke in the air to get away behind her field and never recovered. AMBER BE GOOD chased the pace three wide to the second turn and retreated. STERLING VIXEN opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn, and gave way readily once headed. SLY IN SEATTLE showed little. BARMAID was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and stopped. The Steward conducted an inquiry into the start of PLAIN AND SIMPLE, but following the review made no change.
