Footnotes

EYE FOR AN EYE dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn then repelled bids in the stretch and cleared the field late in the final stages. REBEL RAIDER stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. LUCKY CHUCK was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. KNOWNFORSTONE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. I COME FROM BEHIND was never a threat. ALARMING AFLEET dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch. BAIL US OUT trailed the field throughout.
