PRAIRIE PRIZE set the pressured pace off of the inside, edged clear on the turn, widened entering the stretch and held sway. CUP'N SPOON stalked the pace, launched her bid five wide, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. BOOGIE RED was allowed to settle toward the inside, swung seven wide and was along for the show. TRUE JEAN was forwardly placed along the inside, but weakened during the drive and faded. STUNNING ELECTRA prompted the pace three wide to the stretch and faded. STAR AWARD was allowed to settle, angled in leaving the turn, but lacked a response when called upon. EUROPA ROYALE was allowed to settle, looped up five wide leaving the turn, loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. OH SO SHERRI was fractious in the gate, broke in the air to get away well behind her field and never recovered.
