JUDGE BETH set the pressured pace three wide, opened clear leaving the turn and held safely. DONA MARITZA shifted out five wide after the opening quarter, continued on well through a long drive and clearly proved second best. LOLA GETZ was allowed to settle, circled seven wide and was along for the show. THUNDER REIDE TOO was unhurried into stride, came four wide and improved position. CITIZEN KITTEN was close up four wide but faltered leaving the turn and faded. BEAUTIFUL SCORE passed the tiring ones. JULITA showed little. CHEROKEE RIVER broke slow and was never a factor. SWEET BUT SASSY disputed the pace along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. KAMERON'S TOKEN vied for the lead between horses but stopped before going a half.
