SATAN'S PLUME was shuffled back from between horses early, circled seven wide, closed with a rush and was up in the final strides. BUTTON DANCER pulled to the fore between horses, kept on gamely through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. SAILORS PASTTIME vied for the lead between horses, weakened slightly during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. PIC A CHIC was allowed to settle, split horses to make a late rally and was gaining ground. MUD CREEK pressed the pace along the inside, but weakened during the drive and gave way. SOCIAL CHARMER attended the pace three wide, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. KID SOUP was hustled along five wide and went evenly. MINI LAMP saved ground to no avail. NOTREADYTOBENICE was away alertly and contested the pace four wide for a half and dropped out.
