CATNIRO, wearing a nasal strip, raced within striking distance, commenced his rally three wide on the turn and finished well to be up in time. MANSLEETER vied for the lead from the inside, drew clear in midstretch but could not last. FERENE alternated for the lead off the inside, held gamely after dropping back a bit in midstretch and was coming again late. TAWA RUN outrun early, was five wide on the turn and improved his position while no threat. BLUSHING LOUIE G unhurried early inside, found his best stride too late. SLOT MACHINE, wearing a nasal strip, raced within striking distance in the three path, gave way in the drive. NATIONAL CHAMPION pressed the early pace three wide and faded. SHOW AND GLOW unhurried early four wide, was no factor. ROVELLA'S DENIRO forwardly placed from the start, raced along the inside on the turn and stopped.
