INKI BLANDFORD stalked the pace three deep, launched a bold bid four wide, opened clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. LOVE TO BE WICKED was allowed to settle, advanced between horses on the second turn, came five wide and kept on willingly to prove second best. THUNDER HIGHWAY was allowed to settle while never far back, circled six wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. OKOBOJI VIEW opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch and gave way. MAJOR KEENE chased the pace three wide for six furlongs and faded. NAVAJO PARK passed the tiring ones. NATIONAL TRIBUTE failed to respond. SEINNE SHIP saved ground to no avail. RAJABLOU broke slow, went five wide and was never a factor. BEER FRAME was through early, dropped far back, was eased to the wire but walked off.
