**Footnotes**

IMUSTBEPERFECT sped clear to set the pace, widened entering the stretch, then was all out to keep the fast closing JUSTIFIABLY SALTY at bay. JUSTIFIABLY SALTY was away alertly, settled off of the pace along the inside, was shuffled back in traffic on the turn, swung to the outside nearing the quarter pole, finished with a rush once clear and was gaining with every stride. SHEE'S SWIFT attended the pace between horses, angled in leaving the turn, got through to make her bid but lacked the needed late response. GO SEES made a middle move five wide, loomed a danger leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. MY GAL was allowed to settle, angled out and improved position through the lane. TOUGH NUGGIES was hustled along four wide in mid pack and failed to respond. STICH'S PUBLICPICK pulled to contention four wide, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. LAVEEN'S LEGACY rushed to contention between horses, but came up empty after a half and retreated. STORMY HOT was hung wide and showed little. VALENCIENNE was through early. ASCENDING BRIGHTLY broke slow and was never a factor. HOUSE OF FASHION trailed.
