**Footnotes**

GOLDEN RACHAEL outrun early, advanced four wide on the turn, came out five wide into the stretch, challenged inside the final furlong, gained a short lead near the sixteenth marker then held sway late. ONE TOUGH CAT reserved early, waited behind rivals with three furlongs to go, raced in traffic approaching the stretch, came out four wide leaving the turn, angled out farther then closed well late. PARACLETE within striking distance five wide, lacked the needed late bid. LOGAN'S GIRL vied for the lead while off the inside land held on gamely in the drive. WARSAW CONCERTO alternated for the lead along the inside, came off the rail in upper stretch and held on gamely in the drive. FIRST VIOLIN forwardly placed while off the inside, angled to the rail in upper stretch but lacked a late bid. JOVE'S AUBEE within striking distance, steadied between rivals with three furlongs to go then had little left in the drive. LEGENDARY PEACH never far back along the inside, weakened in the stretch. DASHING GIRL forwardly placed from the start, held on well to midstretch and tired. MOVIN IN close up early, raced four wide into the turn, was in a bit tight approaching the stretch then tired. IN DANCING ORDER was outrun.
