Footnotes

PARADE CLOWN settled in hand along the inside through the first turn, shifted to the outside with six furlongs to run, commenced a long drive circling six wide, struck the front entering the stretch, shook off NO DETOUR and drew clear under steady urging. NO DETOUR stalked the pace three deep, ranged up to engage the leaders leaving the three furlong marker, poked his head in front briefly with five-sixteenths to run, was unable to resist the winner but continued on well to clearly prove second best. DOOKIE DUCK attended the pace two wide, bid between horses on the second turn, was no match for the top two but finished fairly well to safely hold the show. REGAL EAGLE was hustled along in mid pack four wide, failed to seriously threaten but improved his position late. PLATINUM VAN opened clear to set the pace, was collared after five furlongs and gave way readily. KRANZ was away alertly and chased the pace off of the inside to the second turn and tired. DEVIL'S APPRENTICE saved ground to little avail. AZUL MOON was pinched back and clipped heels shortly after the start, bobbed and showed little thereafter. THE BIG HIGHROLLER was always outrun. TEANECK dropped well back through the first turn and trailed throughout.
