**Footnotes**

KENTUCKY TRUST tracked the pace out from the rail, angled three wide into the far turn to bid, dueled outside HESABULLET through the lane and edged clear late. HESABULLET dueled on the pace outside EMPORIA to the far turn, continued on willingly when challenged by the winner to duel that one through the lane and could not last. SUDDEN GLORY saved ground to move up through the far turn then could not threaten the top pair in the drive. GRAVANO moved up six wide on the far turn and continued from wide in the lane. EMPORIA dueled on the pace inside HESABULLET while out from the rail and tired nearing the lane. TALK'S CHEAP was not a factor racing outside. LUCKY SCRIBE moved up three to four wide through the far turn then failed to threaten in the lane. GOLD BEAT lacked any early speed then moved up while angling out in the lane. UNION MILLS tracked the pace from three wide, moved five wide on the far turn and tired. GENERAL MILL tracked the pace racing three to four wide and tired. POWDER KEG tired from along the inside.
