TOSCA'S KISS bobbled early, settled saving ground, angled out to launch her bid, drew even entering the stretch and battled through a prolonged drive to end in a dead heat for the win. BLUE SILK settled in hand, made a middle move four wide, forged command after a half, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of TOSCA'S KISS and had enough left to end on even terms for first. ROMEO LAST MYSTERY contended between horses, came four wide into

the stretch and continued on willingly to earn the show. DADDYS FOUR QUEENS set the pressured pace three wide, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. SONG OF SONGS stalked the pace between horses, angled in entering the stretch to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. NINA NINA broke in the air to get away slowly, made a belated gain four wide but was never a factor. EXCITING SLEW settled in the second flight five wide and failed to respond. PEACHVILLE showed little. MARGARET PRIDE was away alertly and pressed the pace along the inside, but stopped before going a half and faded fast.
