HAIL TO SHILOH disputed the pace three wide, shook clear leaving the turn, was kept to task and maintained a safe advantage. WOODWAY stalked the pace along the inside, angled out five wide to launch his bid, finished with good energy clearly proved second best. PATTERN OF THE CAT prompted the pace between horses, was unable to match strides with the top two through the drive but continued on fairly well to hold the show. ITZA MAKER was away alertly, settled off of the pace along the inside, got through to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. FLEET DAYJUR was allowed to settle into stride, swung seven wide to make a late rally but failed to threaten. JUST PLAYING vied for the lead between horses, weakened leaving the turn, drifted out and faded. MAGICAL FREEDOM settled saving ground and failed to respond. OUR CUP OF SOUP was awkward into stride, raced wide throughout and was never a factor. BRAVE MOTYA was fractious in the gate, dropped far back at once and trailed throughout.
