DONT LIE reserved early, commenced her rally in the four path on the turn, was in traffic in upper stretch then finished fast when clear to be up in time. EXCELLENT FUTURE settled early, advanced four wide on the turn, challenged in upper stretch but was outfinished. BOOM BABY unhurried off the inside, finished well late. UNTHINKABLE outprinted early while off the inside, moved three wide late on the turn and lodged a mild late bid. MISSING SEFA behind the leaders, advanced three wide on the turn, challenged with a quarter mile to go but weakened late. HIGH STRIKE outrun early, raced in the four path on the turn and was no real threat. FEISTY RED could not menace. PRETTY JOSETTE vied for the lead along the inside and tired late. RECALCITRANT forced the pace off the inside and faded. LOVETHEPROSPECT was no factor.
