QUITE EXPLOSIVE set the pace early then drew away from the field through the turn, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole then remained clear in the stretch and held in the final stages. FOURTEENKAROTPRIZE was well placed early, while on the inside into the turn then made a bid in the stretch with a late gain from the inside. POINT AND CLICK pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. CASTLE DREAMER was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn with no late gain in the stretch. SUNLIT fanned into the seven path in the turn and improved position. YOU DON'T KNOW ZIP raced up close early, angled into the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. FOLLOW THE LADY was through after a half. ANGEL HOPE checked into the turn and soon retreated. SHE'S A DREAMER had brief speed then folded up.
