WHATTHECATDRUGIN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. YO COLTRANE tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. WONKA stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch run. BROTHER STUART was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. BRICKYARD was on the inside into the far turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch. BAIL US OUT was never a threat. VALIENT TENOBOB chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
