TIGHT STORM forwardly placed, reeled in the leader while three wide, repulsed a bid by the runner up in midstretch and drew clear late. SILK DEGREES stumbled at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, advanced four wide on the turn, caught the winner in midstretch and held on gamely. GENUINENESS forwardly placed along the inside, lacked a late bid. ONLY closest to the early pace off the inside, angled out once in the stretch and tired. LUKES BROWN GIRL outrun early, raced five wide late on the turn and was no threat. NATIVE DRESS angled in early, saved ground on the turn and could not menace. WATCHFUL CHEROKEE was no factor. HARFORD HILL steadied early and was outrun. BEST VOW was always well back. BRIGHT OUTLOOK four wide late on the turn, gave way. LEVITY sprinted clear and angled in, set the early pace and stopped. CINDARELLA GIRL as outrun.
