LAZ HAS RISEN stalked pace to the turn, was blocked entering the stretch angled in for room and responded with a rush to draw clear late. PAPAL pressed pace to the stretch, drew even in the late going but was outfinished. SPANISH MISSION good speed to deep stretch but weakened in the going late. ESPRIT DU ROI (CHI) raced in perfect position to deep stretch but came up empty in the drive. E A LOCKWOOD raced evenly and lacked a late response. PODGY had good position to the turn, drifted out into the stretch and faded. CHARLIE V. was through after a half. DOUBLE SHOTGUN bore out at the start and failed to menace. POLO GROUNDS was outrun. COESSE CHIEF was through early.
