Footnotes

GRAND DADDY broke slowly from the gate and trailed the field early from the outside, angled into the five path in the turn while circling the field then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leaders in the final stages. THREEFORALL tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but steadied a bit and flattened out late. SASSOU was bumped at the start then set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drifted out in the stretch and yielded late. UNSADDLED GLORY broke out at the start then chased the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch run. BEE LINE'S EDGE was bumped at the start, angled into the four path in the turn with no late gain in the stretch. POWER OF TITUS ran evenly throughout. BISCOTTO was done early. TIMBUCTO raced up close early then steadied in the turn and faded late.
