FOREVER TODAY set the pace off the inside, took over on the turn and increased his lead under steady urging. SASHITA forced the pace from the inside, made several moves at the winner, could not cope with that one late but was clearly second best. BELLA NORTH prompted the pace three wide and tired. JENEL'S JOBLESS outrun early, raced in the five path on the turn and was no threat. LOVIN SABRINA behind the leaders four wide, faded. PROUD LIL SIS failed to menace while in the four path. ANGEL IN BLUE unprepared for the start, drifted in after breaking and steadied then was no threat. BIG OAK LADY sluggish at the start, was no factor.
